Camera Ready Paper Submission Instructions for Authors

The following are the instructions to work out your Camera-Ready Paper, including the details for generation of e-Copyright Form (eCF)

Note:

1. All accepted papers including poster presentations will be published in the conference proceedings

2. Full length papers should not exceed SIX(6) pages, including figures, tables and references. Papers exceeding the normal length may be submitted upon payment of over length page charges of 25 USD for each page in excess of six. A maximum of two extra pages above normal six are permitted.

Step 1: Prepare your revised final manuscript

Before submitting the paper, please ensure that

- The reviewer suggestions (if any) are taken care of. **NO** changes other than the reviewer suggestion are acceptable at this stage.
- There are no grammatical, spelling, or content errors
- The figures and tables are of high quality and their content is reader-friendly
- The paper contains **no headers, no footers, and no page numbers.** This information will be added by the conference publication team.
- Do add all author name/affiliation as per IEEE guidelines. **NO** modification / addition in author list is allowed.

Step 2: IEEE-Xplore-compatible PDF generation

The final paper should be in PDF form and should comply with the requirements of the IEEE Xplore digital library. This needs to be carried out using IEEE PDF eXpress web tool. PDF files generated in a different way may not be IEEE Xplore-compliant and may not be published. Please follow the instructions below.

Log in into IEEE PDF eXpress account the following conference ID: **60093X**. Create a new account if you are a first-time user.

Please upload the source files of your camera-ready paper for conversion. IEEE PDF eXpress supports the following formats

- Microsoft Word
- La)TeX (LaTeXsouce file and supported image files must be included in a compressed zip archive)

Alternatively, you can also just check the compliance of your generated PDF file. If the submitted PDF is according to the norms, then you will receive a confirmation of the same to your registered e-mail ID, along with the IEEE- Xplore-compatible PDF version of your paper as an attachment. If not, your will get an error report to your registered e-mail ID. Correct the errors and iterate the process until you succeed.

Step 3: Final submission of paper and e-Copyright Form (eCF)
