

## **CAMERA READY INSTRUCTIONS**

Thank you for your patience. Below are the instructions to work out your Camera-Ready Paper, including the details for generation of e-Copyright Form (eCF)

### **Note:**

1. All accepted papers including poster presentations will be published in the conference proceedings
2. Full length papers should not exceed SIX(6) pages, including figures, tables and references.

### **Step 1: Prepare your revised final manuscript**

Before submitting the paper, please ensure that

- The reviewer suggestions (if any) are taken care of. **NO** changes other than the reviewer suggestion are acceptable at this stage.
- There are no grammatical, spelling, or content errors
- The figures and tables are of high quality and their content is reader-friendly
- The paper contains **no headers, no footers, and no page numbers**. This information will be added by the conference publication team.
- Do add all author name/affiliation as per IEEE guidelines. **NO** modification / addition in author list is allowed.

### **Step 2: IEEE-Xplore-compatible PDF generation**

The final paper should be in PDF form and should comply with the requirements of the IEEE Xplore digital library. This needs to be carried out using [IEEE PDF eXpress](#) web tool. PDF files generated in a different way may not be IEEE Xplore-compliant and may not be published. Please follow the instructions below.

- Log in into [IEEE PDF eXpress](#) account the following conference ID: **57277X**. Create a new account if you are a first-time user.
- Please upload the source files of your camera-ready paper for conversion. IEEE PDF eXpress supports the following formats
  - Microsoft Word
  - (La)TeX (LaTeX source file and supported image files must be included in a compressed zip archive)
- Alternatively, you can also just check the compliance of your generated PDF file.
- If the submitted PDF is according to the norms, then you will receive a confirmation of the same to your registered e-mail ID, along with the IEEE-

Xplore-compatible PDF version of your paper as an attachment. If not, you will get an error report to your registered e-mail ID. Correct the errors and iterate the process until you succeed.

The IEEE-Xplore-compatible PDF version can be downloaded from IEEE PDF eXpress as well. The final name will be of the type PIDXXXXXX.pdf. Rename the PDF as VSLID\_2023\_**PaperID**.pdf. The **PaperID** is the ID of your paper at the time of submission.'

### **Step 2(a): Generation of e-Copyright Form (eCF)**

- Please go to the user console of softconf submission site. [https://www.softconf.com/m/vlsid2023/]
- Click "Your current Submission" Tab
- Go to your paper
- Click on the "Copyright Submission" Tab
- This will direct you to IEEE site.
- Fill all the details as per the IEEE norms.
- Download the filled-in eCF (PDF format)
- Upload the eCF in the softconf portal.

**Please complete the process by Mon 28<sup>th</sup> Nov '22.**

The templates for paper presentations and posters will be uploaded on the website by 27-Nov '22. You will also receive an email from [vlsid.2023.submissions@gmail.com](mailto:vlsid.2023.submissions@gmail.com) with your personalized space to upload your presentations/posters with detailed instructions.

Ensure at least one author of each selected paper / poster is registered under Author category on the conference registration portal.
